ORDER

Whereas amidst compelling circumstances and due to the sudden spurt in the spread of the severe and deadly COVID-19 pandemic, affecting the lives of people, this Tribunal, vide Order No.NCLT/KB/77/2021-2022/1041, Dated: 26/4/2021, read with Order No.: NCLT/KB/77/2021-22/1050, Dated: 13/5/2021, had decided that the Members along with all Officials of this Tribunal shall work from home only, till the afternoon of the 21st May, 2021, followed by functioning of the vacation Bench with effect from the 24th May, 2021 till 06th June, 2021, in accordance with Order issued vide File No.: 10/03/2021-NCLT, Dated: 07th May, 2021, of the National Company Law Tribunal, New Delhi;

Whereas it has now transpired that upon recommendations of the Executive Committee of the West Bengal State Disaster Management Authority, the Chief Secretary to the Government of West Bengal, vide Order No.: 707-ISS/2M-22/2020, dated: 29/5/2021, has extended the restriction measures, up to 6 PM of Tuesday, 15th June, 2021, in terms of the provisions under Disaster Management Act, 2005 read with West Bengal Epidemic Disease, Covid-19 Regulations, 2020, as notified in Order dated: 15/5/2021 read with Order dated: 23/5/2021, of the Chief Secretary to the Government of West Bengal; and

Whereas in terms of the aforesaid Orders of the West Bengal State Government, all Government Offices & Private establishments shall remain closed except those relating to emergency & essential services and all modes of transport comprising intra-state local trains, metro railway, and intra state bus services and inland water transport including movement of private vehicles, taxis and auto-rickshaws will be prohibited except for medical and emergency or essential purposes.

Now, therefore, in considerations of such restrictions imposed by the State Government to be in force till 6 PM of Tuesday, 15th June, 2021, it is ordered that the existing mode of work from home shall continue for this Tribunal till the evening of Tuesday, the 15th June, 2021.

However, be it mentioned here that this Tribunal shall continue to function in virtual mode through Video Conference for taking up only urgent matters, as already Ordered by the National Company Law Tribunal, New Delhi, in File No.: 10/03/2021, dated: the 19th April, 2021.

Filing of matters by the Professionals / Litigants, and their scrutiny by the Registry, shall continue as usual through E-Filing Portal.
