It appears that counter has already been filed by R1 & R2. However, even after the specific order dated 3.02.2021 directing the respondents 4&5 to file the counter within 3 weeks, counter of R4 & R5 have not yet been filed. They had not sought link to appear through VC. It is presumed that they have no intention to file a reply. Hence the right of Respondents 4 & 5 to file the counter stands struck off.

Vide order dated 03.02.2021, R1 was directed to provide the proof of conduct of AGMs, EGMs and Board Meetings of the Company for the period from 2008 to 2018 and to provide the proof of service of notice on the petitioners within two weeks from 17.12.2020.
