ORDER

During the course of arguments, learned Counsel for the applicant was asked whether any reply to the statutory demand notice issued under Section 8 has been filed and a short reply was given on 09.11.2017 stating that detailed reply was in the process of being finalised. Eventually, detailed reply was sent to applicant on 19.12.2017, which has not been placed on record. However, learned Counsel has shown a copy of the same to us. In para 3(b) of that reply, State Trading Corporation of India Limited has stated that till the date of filing reply, no re-conciliation of accounts had been finalised between STC and BORL, therefore, the payment to the applicant could not be made.
