Heard Mr. Siddharth Sancheti, learned counsel for the petitioner. Also heard Mr. H.K.Baruah, learned counsel appearing on behalf of all the respondents and in that connection, he has filed Vakalatnama as well.

Mr. Baruah, learned counsel for the respondents submits that he had received the notice along with the copies of the petition as well as copies of other connected documents but he was not in a position to file reply to the petition for want of sufficient time. He, therefore, requests this Tribunal for extension of time to file reply to the petition.

In that connection, I have heard Mr.Siddharth Sancheti, learned counsel for the petitioner who submits that the petition and connected documents have been delivered to the Postal Department well in time and therefore the petitioner has reasoned to believe that notice has been received by the respondents in time.
