

## **ORDER**

- 1. Petition admitted.
- 2. Petition fixed for hearing and final disposal on 21st February, 2018.
- 3. Learned Counsel for the Petitioner Company states that in pursuance of the directions contained in Order dated 15th November, 2017, passed by the National Law Company Tribunal, Mumbai Bench ('Tribunal') in Company Scheme Application No. 977 of 2017, notices have been served upon all the Regulatory Authorities namely (i) concerned Income Tax Authorities with in whose jurisdiction the Petitioner Company's assessments are made, (ii) the Regional Director, Western Region, Mumbai, (iii) Registrar of Companies, (iv) the Securities and Exchange Board of India, (v) the National Stock Exchange, (vi) the Bombay Stock Exchange, (vii) the National Housing Bank and (viii) the Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority of India as per Rule 8 of the Companies (Compromises, Arrangements and Amalgamations) Rules, 2016.
- 4. The Learned Counsel for the Petitioner Company further submits that the Company Scheme Petition is filed in consonance with section 230 to 232 and other applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013.
- 5. At least ten (10) days before the date fixed for hearing, the Petitioner Company to publish the notice of hearing of Petition in two local newspaper viz. "Free Press Journal", in English language and translation thereof in "Navshakti", in Marathi language, both having circulation in Mumbai as per Rule 16 of the Companies (Compromises, Arrangements and Amalgamations) Rules, 2016.
- 6. The Petitioner Company to file an affidavit of service regarding the directions given by the Tribunal and do report to this Tribunal that the direction regarding the issue of advertisement of the notice has been duly complied with.
