ORDER

Further the petitioner is also directed to give notice of hearing to the Registrar of Companies, Regional Director on behalf of Central Government and to the

Income Tax Department as well as to the Official Liquidator at least 30 days before the date of hearing. On receipt of notice, the above said authorities shall file their representations / objection, if any, within a period of 30 days from the date of receipt of notice. The petitioners shall individually file affidavit of service / compliance with the above said directions at least 7 days before the date of hearing fixed as above of the petition.
