Advocate, Ms. Shrankhla Yadav for the Financial Creditor. Today, the Respondent Corporate Debtor is absent despite service of proper notice. Further, the petitioner counsel files an affidavit of service of notices issued, which is taken on record. The Registry of this Tribunal points out some procedural defects in the petition, which need to be removed and to be replied properly, failing which, the petition may be treated as an incomplete and may liable to be rejected for want of statutory compliance under Section 7(5) of I & B Code of 2016.

Therefore, a formal notice to the Corporate Debtor Company be issued under Section 7(5) of I & B Code, 2016. The petitioner is expected to make a reply within statutory period.


