As per the 3rd event report filed by the IRP, the suspended

management/Board of Directors of the Corporate Debtor is not co-operating

with the IRP and they are not providing the books of account and other

records of the company. Notice be issued to the suspended Board of

Directors of the Corporate Debtor for 17.01.2018 to appear in person or

through authorised representative and to furnish explanation regarding non

co-operative conduct of the Corporate Debtor, which they are supposed to

comply by virtue of Section 19 of the Insolvency & Bankruptcy Code, 2016.

The IRP present shall collect the notices from the registry and send the

same to the suspended management/key managerial person(s) of the

Corporate Debtor immediately by e-mail.

In the meanwhile, the present IRP shall keep on sending

the progress reports.
