It is also directed to file amended memo of parties impleaded petitioner No.1 as also to implead Riti Gupta, the daughter who is minor through her next friend. deceased through the legal representatives with their complete address and

The file was received by transfer from the Company Law Board and taken up for the first time by the Tribunal on 25.07.2016. It was informed on behalf of petitioner on 09.09.2016 that petitioner No.1 has died and application has been filed today for impleading legal representatives of deceased petitioner No.1. The application has been disposed of today and matter is now fixed for filing of amended memo of parties and the power of attorney for 24.10.2016. In view of the above, a request be submitted to the Hon'ble President, National Company Law Tribunal, New Delhi seeking three months more time for disposal of the case.
