<u>ORDER</u>

Counsel for Petitioner present. Counsel for R1 to R3 and R7 to R48 present. Counsel for R4 to R6 also present. The matter has been fixed for final arguments. However, Counsel for R1 to R3 and R7 to R48 submitted that they are intending to settle the matter as there are issues to be sorted out by the respective parties, therefore, opportunity to be given by granting three months' time for reporting settlement. Counsel for the Petitioner opposed the proposal stating that earlier many opportunities have been given but there was no settlement between the parties. Therefore, opportunity may not be granted. The Bench suggested that any Mediator could be appointed but the same has been opposed by the Counsel for Respondents. In the circumstances, there is a requirement to grant more time as last and final opportunity for arriving at the settlement between the parties, failing which the matter shall be taken up for final hearing without granting any further adjournment.
