## **ORDER**

Shri P Duraiswamy, 1st Petitioner in person present. Shri R Ashok Kumar, counsel for R1, R3 to R6 present. Petitioner submitted two names, Shri Gopalashankar and Shri Chellakumar and two names have been suggested by the counsel for respondents, Ms Chitra Narayanan and Shri R Srivatsan from Coimbatore for the appointment of mediators in order to settle the dispute between the shareholders. We are inclined to appoint Shri Gopalashankar, from petitioner's side and Shri R Srivatsan, from respondent's side as mediators. Both the mediators are directed to explore the possibilities of settlement between the petitioner and respondents. The parties shall bear the remuneration 50:50. They are also allowed to fix their remuneration for the purpose of mediation as per the practice in vogue. Petitioner and the counsel for

respondents are directed to serve copy of this order on the mediators and facilitate them to complete the process of mediation within four weeks from the receipt of the date of this order and report to this Bench. Petitioner has filed a memo with a prayer to receive the cheque to the tune of Rs.5,47,638.00 which has been given by State Bank of India in favour of R1 company as excess amount paid against the outstanding amount. The same is taken on record. Petitioner submitted that he has contributed all the money from his personal resources and paid to the Bank and excess amount which has been returned by way of cheque No.361086 dated 31.3.2017 in favour of the company be permitted to be taken to his personal account. We direct Shri D Venugopal and Ms J Manjula, R3 & R6 who are reportedly the present directors of R1 company to convene a meeting and decide the claim of the first petitioner in relation to the cheque in question and report to this Bench by the next date of hearing.
